When and where: The camp will be at Shiloh Bible Camp from November 13 – 15. Check in will begin at 8:00 pm on Friday, November 13th (please eat dinner before arriving) and will end at 1:00 pm on Sunday, November 15th.

How do I get there: The camp is located just outside Donnelly ID. In Donnelly, turn west off Hwy. 55 onto Roseberry Rd. Go approximately 2 miles then turn north onto Gestrin Rd. and proceed about 1□4 mile. Transportation is provided for this camp. If you choose to ride the bus, there is an additional \$20 fee to cover the cost of transportation.

What to bring: Personal Articles: Bible, pen, notebook, flashlight, camera, sleeping bag & pillow, bath towel, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, modest warm clothes, sturdy tennis shoes, extra pair of shoes for wet weather, warm coat, etc. The weather will likely be cool and there may be rain or snow.
