Who is invited: This retreat is for families of all ages and from all walks of life. There will be some group and individual activities available, as well as some free time to allow families to explore the area, enjoy the outdoors, and spend some quality time together.

When and where: The camp will be at Shiloh Bible Camp from August 30 – September 2, 2019. Registration will begin at 4:00 pm on Friday, August 30th and will end at 10:30 am on Monday, September 2nd.

How do I get there: The camp is located just outside Donnelly ID. In Donnelly, turn west off Hwy. 55 onto Roseberry Rd. Go approximately 2 miles then turn north onto Gail-Alan Rd. and proceed about 1/4 mile. Bus transportation will **not** be available for this camp.

What to bring: Personal Articles: Bible, pen, notebook, flashlight, camera, sleeping bag & pillow, bath towel, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, **modest** warm clothes, **modest** swimming attire (no bikini's or speedos), sturdy tennis shoes, extra pair of shoes for wet weather, warm coat, etc.

What NOT to bring: It is recommended that families keep all technology put away during the retreat. It is our desire that families disconnect for technology and connect with each other.

- Pets are not allowed on camp property. Exceptions can be made for service animals; however, prior notice is required.
- All forms of alcohol or tobacco and any and all forms of illegal drugs.
- Any & all forms of weapons (including pocket knives).

Registration: Registration can be completed online at shilohbibleconference.com. In order to be considered registered for the retreat, online registrations must be completed in its entirety, unless a Shiloh Executive Staff member gives prior permission.

Cost: Age 4 and under: Free; Age 5-12: \$20 per person; Age 13+: \$45 per person; Max \$135 per immediate family.

Housing: Bring your own RV or tent, or reserve a cabin. Housing will be granted based on order of registration. **Spaces are limited**, so be sure to register soon.
