Who is invited: This retreat is for ladies of all ages. When and where: The camp will be at Shiloh Bible Camp from February  $21^{st} - 23^{rd}$ . Check in will begin at 8:00 pm on Friday, February  $21^{st}$  (please eat dinner before arriving) and will end at 11:30 am on Sunday, February  $23^{rd}$ .

**How do I get there:** The camp is located just outside Donnelly ID. In Donnelly, turn west off Hwy. 55 onto Roseberry Rd. Go approximately 2 miles then turn north onto Gail-Alan Rd. and proceed about 1/4 mile. Bus transportation will **not** be available for this camp.

What to bring: Personal Articles: Bible, pen, notebook, flashlight, camera, sleeping bag & pillow, bath towel, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, modest warm clothes, modest swimming attire (no bikini's or speedos), sturdy tennis shoes, extra pair of shoes for wet weather, warm coat, etc. Plan on cold weather with a significant amount of snow.

**What NOT to bring:** We encourage all participants to spend a weekend away from technology. If possible, cell phones and other technology should be stored away during the camp. Disconnecting from technology is a great way for families to reconnect and grow in their faith.

Any & all forms of weapons (including pocket knives). Any "leave at home" items will be confiscated and kept in the camp office until the end of camp.
