Who is invited: This retreat is for young adults between the ages of 18 and 28 seeking to deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ. It is designed for those who have a real passion to know, love and live for their Savior. Come prepared to have your faith challenged in chapel times, devotions, fellowship and group outings.

When and where: The camp will be at Shiloh Bible Camp from January 8 – 10, 2020. Check in will begin at 8:00 pm on Friday, January 8th (please eat dinner before arriving) and will end at 11:30 am on Sunday, January 10th.

How do I get there: The camp is located just outside Donnelly ID. In Donnelly, turn west off Hwy. 55 onto Roseberry Rd. Go approximately 2 miles then turn north onto Gestrin Rd. and proceed about 1/4 mile. Transportation is NOT provided for this retreat. It is recommended that participants carpool with other attendees from their area.

What to bring: Personal Articles: Bible, pen, notebook, flashlight, camera, sleeping bag & pillow, bath towel, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, **modest** warm clothes, sturdy tennis shoes, extra pair of shoes for wet weather, warm coat, etc. Plan on cold weather with a significant amount of snow.
