Who is Invited: Summer camps are intended for campers between the ages of 8 and 18. They are designed for those who would like to be introduced to the love of Jesus and all who have a desire to grow in their relationship with Him and have some fun with other campers at the same time. Come prepared to have your faith challenged in chapel times, devotions, fellowship and skills classes.

When and Where: Summer camps will be held at Shiloh Bible Camp between June 22<sup>nd</sup> and July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020. Check-In will be at 2 pm on Mondays and Checkout at 11:30 am on Fridays or Saturdays (depending on the camp).

How Do I Get There: The camp is located just outside Donnelly, ID. In Donnelly, turn west off Hwy. 55 onto Roseberry Rd. Go approximately 2 miles, then turn North (right) onto Gestrin Rd. and proceed about ¼ mile. Bus transportation will be available for all summer camps.

**Registration Details:** Registration for camp can be completed online at shilohbibleconference.com. In order to be considered registered for camp, online registration must be completed in its entirety, unless prior permission is given by the Shiloh Executive Staff. Complete and bring the Canteen Form at the back of this brochure to earn Shiloh Bucks to be used in the camp store.

If your camper has a fever with sore throat, and/or cough in the seven days prior to camp, we ask that you please DO NOT send them to camp. If your camper has been exposed to an influenza like illness in the last seven days, we ask that you notify us of this contact. All campers need to be 48 hours "symptom free" (including off of fever reducing medications) before arriving at camp.

### **Summer Camp Program**

Chapel Times: Singing and Biblical challenge twice a day.

Activities: Make your choice(s) for the week upon arrival at Shiloh. **Bible Quizzing:** Teams compete against each other in an exciting competition. This year's quiz will be from the book of Philippians (older three camps).

Other Activities: Cabin Clean-up Competition, Mail Call, Cabin Devotions, Daily Rest Time, Organized Games, Rafting (14-18 year old camp), etc.

**Ultimate Challenge:** Crazy, fun and wild games!

Shiloh's 10 – 12 year old camp is geared towards students who are in the traditional 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades. Campers will participate in chapel and worship, along with indoor and outdoor activities, swimming, Bible quizzing, ultimate challenge, and cabin competitions. This year's guest speaker will be Child Evangelism Fellowship Teacher, Mike Crase. Mike Crase has been teaching in the public school system for 25+ years, has led numerous Good News Clubs, and has led trainings on teaching Good News Clubs within public schools. He is married to Debbie Crase and they have four children and ten grandchildren.

She and her husband were raised in Idaho and have raised their four children in Meridian, Idaho. All four of her children have grown up attending and serving at Shiloh Bible Camp. She looks forward to joining the Shiloh team for another week of adventure!

Cost for this camp is \$100. Bus transportation is available from the greater Boise area for an additional \$10 each way. Shiloh's 12 – 14 year old camp is geared towards students who are in the traditional 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades. Campers will participate in chapel and worship, along with indoor and outdoor activities, swimming, Bible quizzing, ultimate challenge, and cabin competitions.

### 14 – 18 Year Old Camp July 20 – 25, 2020



Shiloh's 14 – 18 year old camp is geared towards students who are in the traditional 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades. Campers will participate in chapel and worship, along with indoor and outdoor activities, swimming, Bible quizzing, ultimate challenge, and cabin competitions. This year's guest speaker will be Pastor Shaun Thomas. Pastor Shaun has been serving God since 1998, and ministering to the youth in the Donnelly community for the past 12 years. He loves working with the youth and believes that they will be the generation to take the church to the next level. His passion is to share the love and truth of Jesus Christ.

Cost for this camp is \$110. Bus transportation is available from the greater Boise area for an additional \$10 each way.

### What to Bring:

Medications: All medications must be turned into the camp nurse upon arrival, and must be in the original bottle with prescription label intact. The camp provides a nurse's station with normal over the counter medications. Clothes: Modest (see below) swimming suit. (Bikinis and speedos are not allowed.) Casual clothes suitable to camp activities. Be prepared for warm & cool temps, sun and rain. Mornings and evenings can be cold at Shiloh. Shoes & extra shoes. Please bring sturdy tennis shoes for game time. Please note: all clothes and swimming attire must be modest by our judgment. If we deem something to be inappropriate for camp, you will be asked to change or wear additional clothing. Dress in a modest manner and all logos or phrases should be appropriate.

**Personal Articles:** Bible, pen, notebook, flashlight, camera (cell phones are not allowed to be used as cameras), water bottle, sleeping bag, pillow, bath towel, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, hair care items, sunscreen, mosquito repellant, etc.

**Spending Money:** Camp T-shirts, hats, mugs, water bottles, cinch packs, canteen treats, etc. Spending money can be added at time of registration so that campers do not need to carry cash to camp. Cash brought to camp will be collected at registration to be kept safe. All unspent money will be returned to the camper at checkout.

### What NOT to Bring

All ELECTRONIC DEVICES such as music players, movie players, cell phones (not allowed as alarm clocks or cameras), games, computers, internet devices, etc.

All fantasy games.

Any and all forms of matches/lighters.

Any and all forms of weapons (including pocket knives).

All forms of tobacco and alcohol and any and all forms of illegal drugs. Leave-at-home items will be collected at registration for safe keeping and returned during checkout at the end of camp.
